Notice is hereby given that sealed bids for procurement of **115 KV STRUCTURES AND EQUIPMENT** will be received at the office of Mr. Brian Choquette, General Manager, Hudson Light and Power Department, 49 Forest Avenue, Hudson, Massachusetts 01749 until **2:00 p.m., Thursday, January 26, 2023** at which place and time said bids will be opened publicly and read aloud. Bids must be received as follows: ***one (1) original hard copy, two (2) copies, and one (1) electronic copy saved to a thumb drive (the thumb drive must be labeled with the Bidder's name and Project Contract No.).*** Bids must be submitted to the Owner in a SEALED envelope marked "**HLPD BID NO. 912409-01, FOREST AVENUE SUBSTATION 115 KV STRUCTURES AND EQUIPMENT**".

This bid is for procurement only of the following items: One (1) lot of 115 kV Substation Structures and Equipment.

The contract documents may be requested from the Owners Engineer, PLM Electric Power Engineering, Please contact Michael Barrett, mcbarratt@plmnet.com, to obtain an E-Mail copy of the documents.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check payable to the Hudson Light and Power Department for a sum not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid (***indicate HLPD Bid No. 912409-01 on check***), or accompanied by a bid bond in like amount of a corporate surety licensed to do business in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. The successful bidder must furnish insurance certificates or copies of insurance policies, if required, within ten (10) calendar days of the award.

If the successful bidder fails to enter into the contract and furnish the required forms, the bidder may forfeit the bid surety, at the option of the Owner.

Bids shall be prepared, considered and the contract awarded in accordance with MGL Chapter 164, Section 56D and all statutes governing such contracts. Every bid shall be on forms furnished by the Hudson Light and Power Department. Bids submitted on other forms may be rejected.

All bids must be made on the Bid Form provided in these specifications, unless additional space is required for terms and conditions or technical deviations, in which case a supplementary sheet on bidders letterhead or quotation form may be used, and shall become a part of the Bid Form. Hudson Light and Power Department specifically reserves the right to reject any bid not made on the form provided, to waive any irregularity or informality, to reject any or all bids, or to accept any bid which is deemed to be in the best interest of the Hudson Light and Power Department, and the Town of Hudson, Massachusetts.
